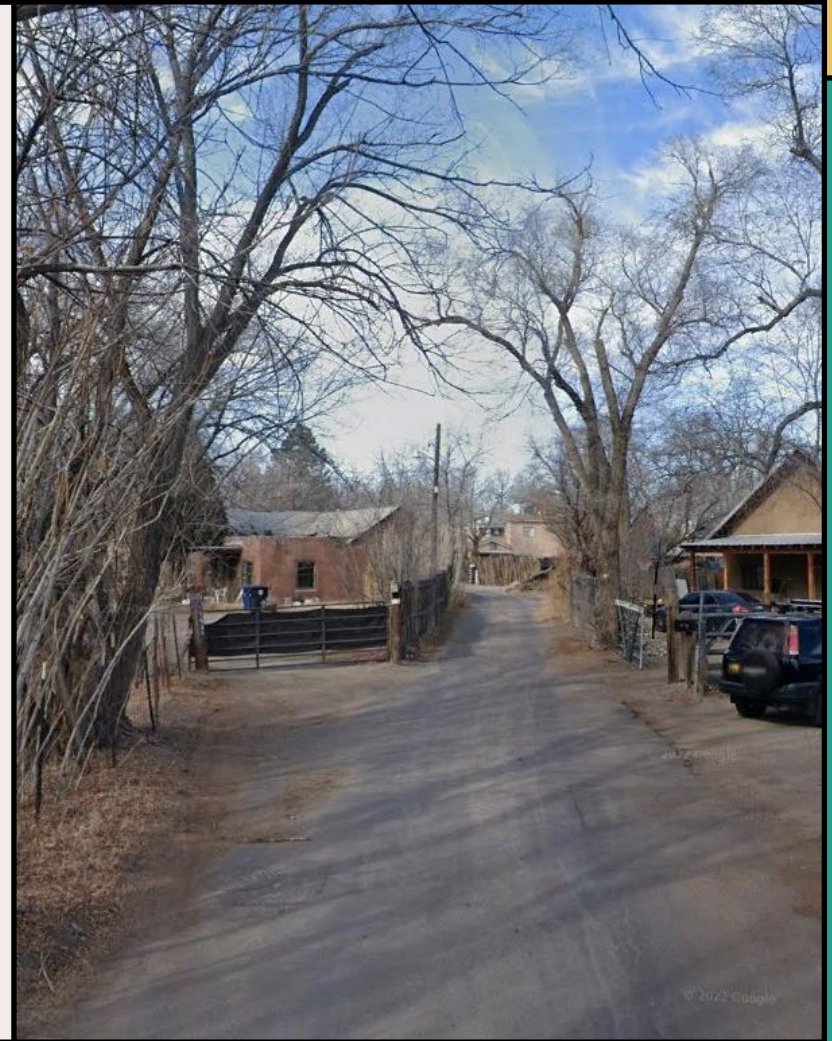

Historic properties include many different types of places and buildings.



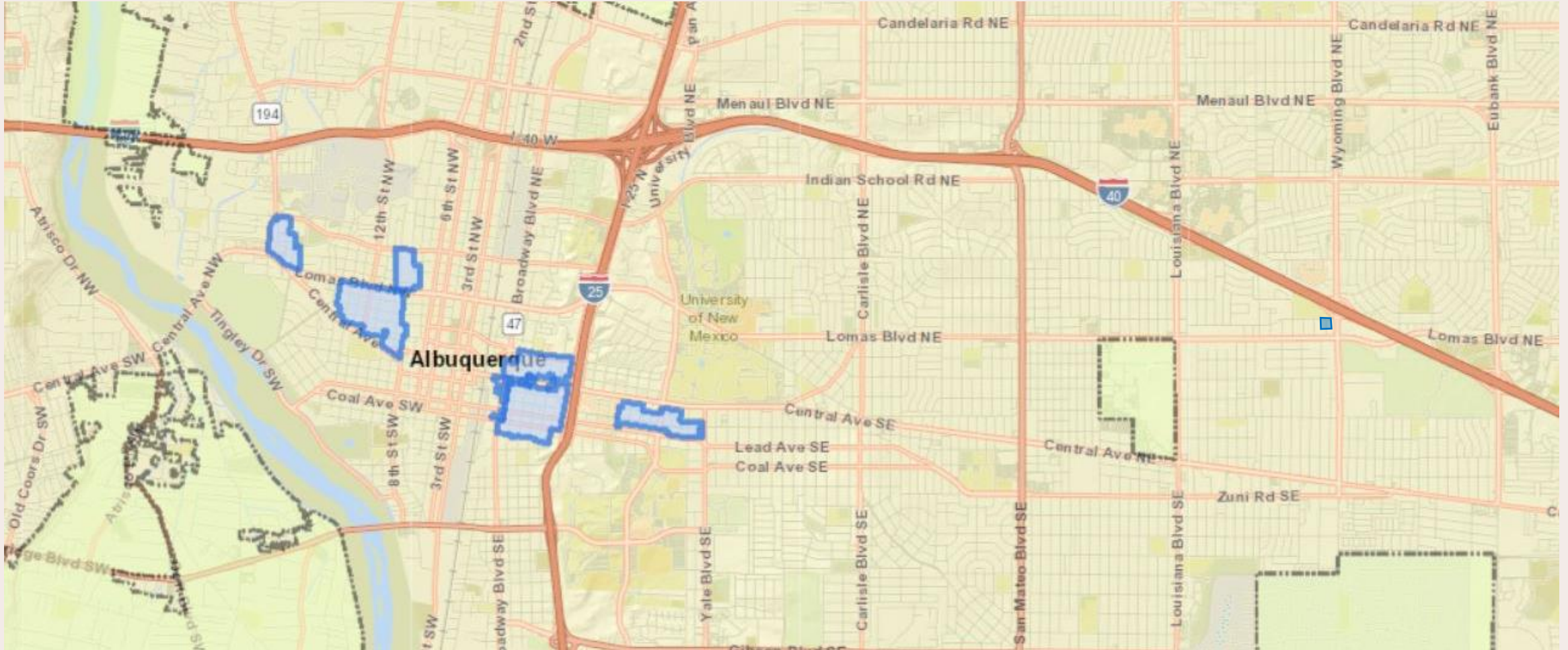
# Primary goals

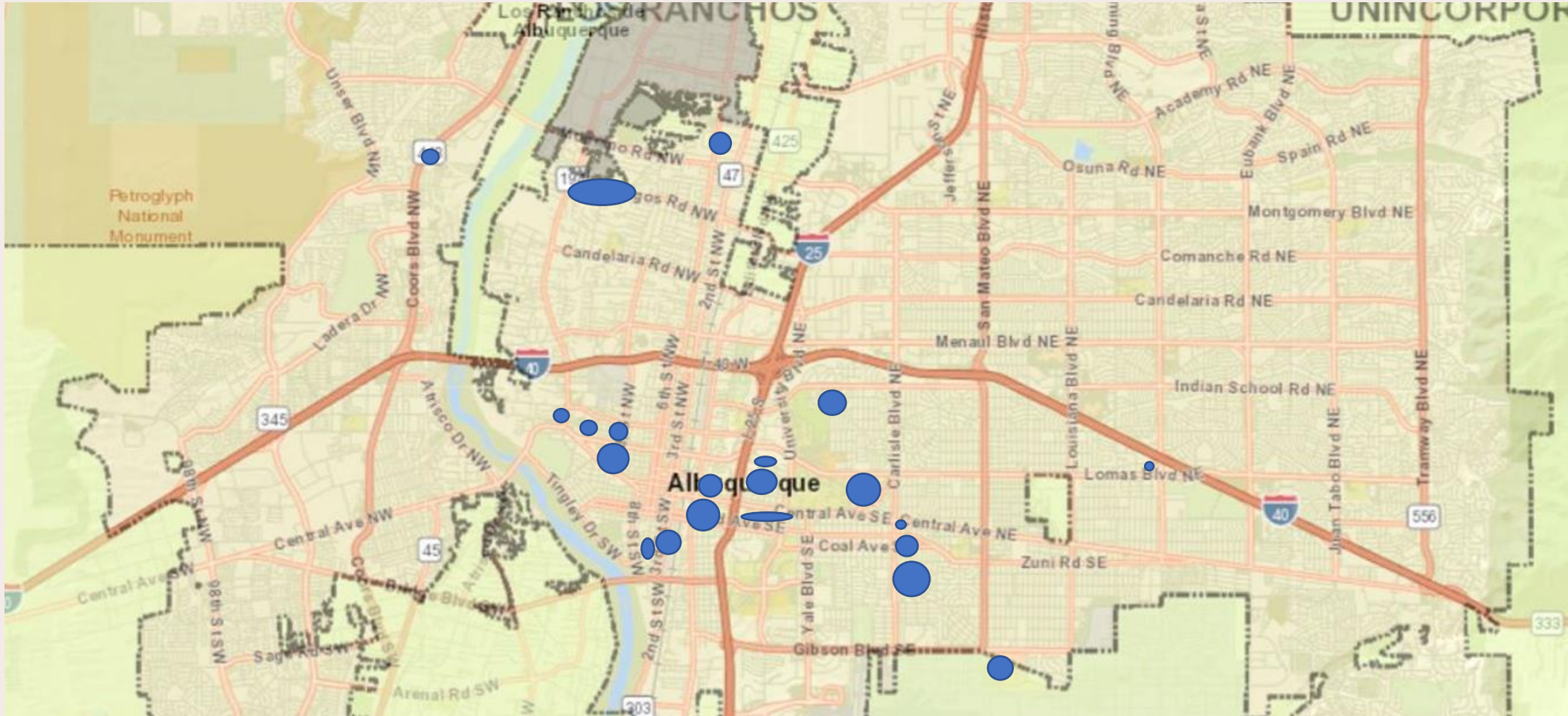

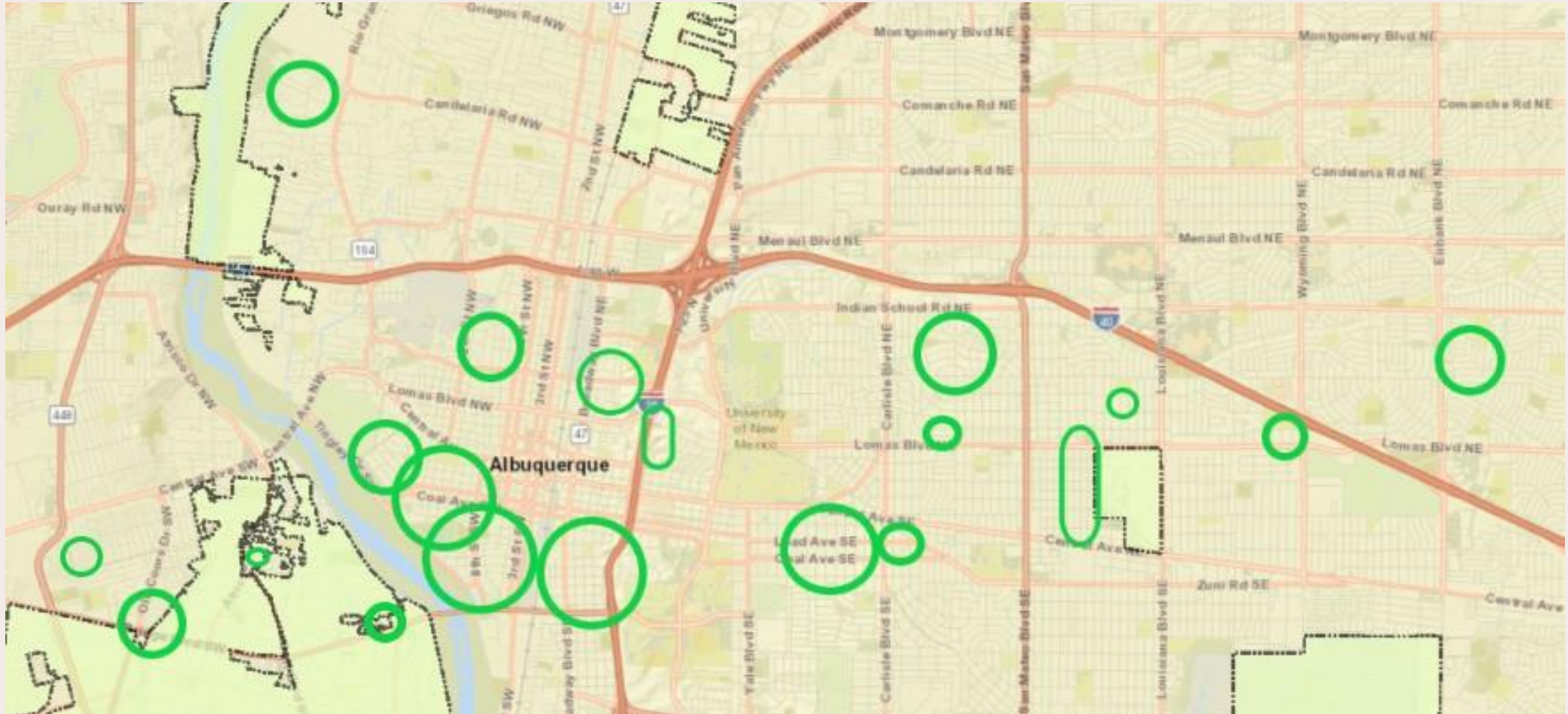

# Possible Historic Districts



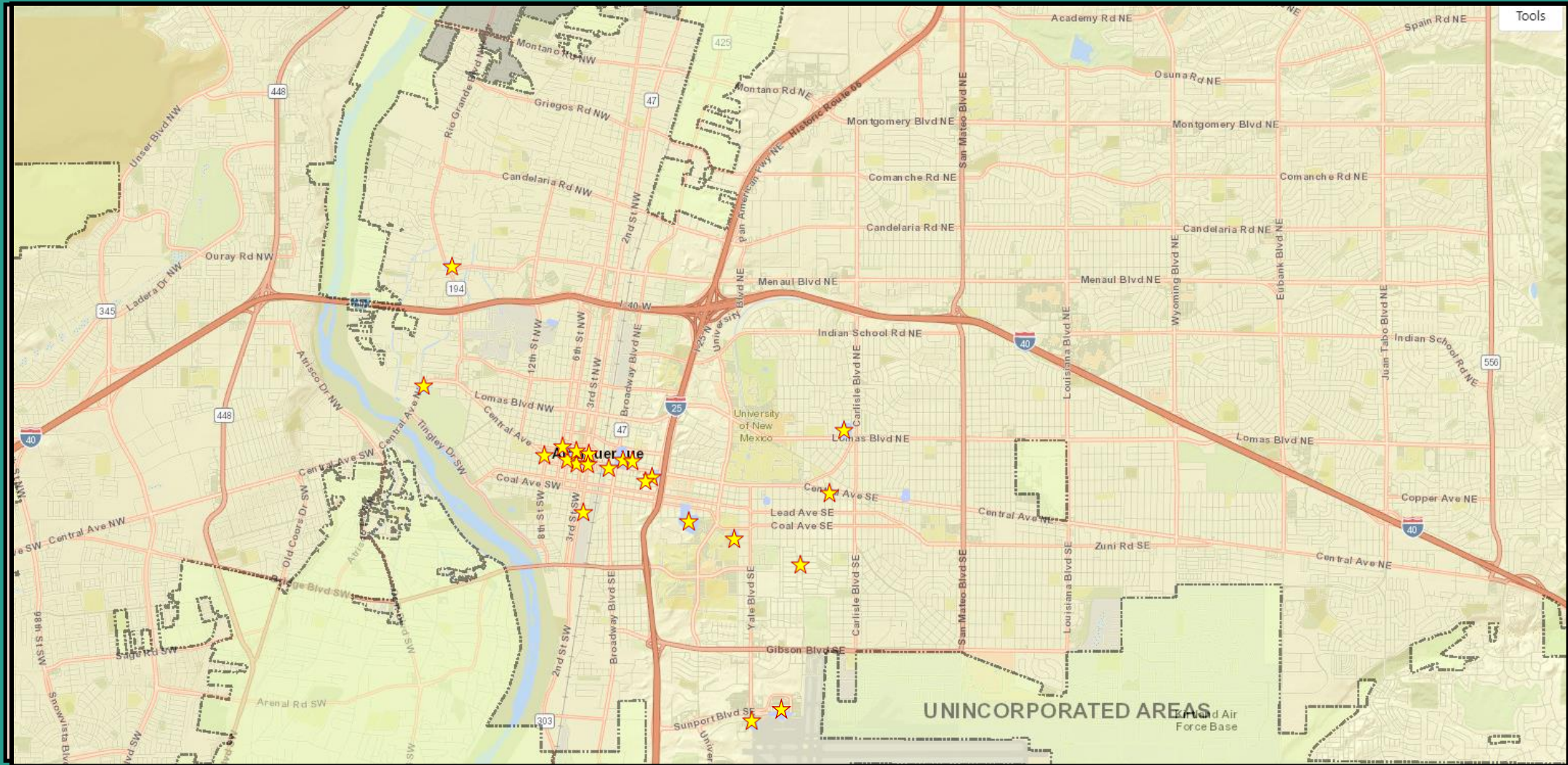

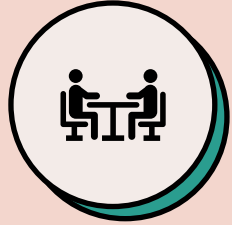

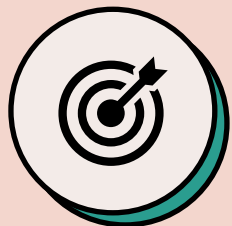

## Health, Housing & Homelessness

May have redevelopment funds

Provides gap funding towards the new construction or acquisition/rehabilitation and/or preservation of multi-family, rental housing units for persons at or below 80% of the Area Median Income.

## Youth and Family Services

Works with HUD as part of our continuing objective to assist public service agencies, eligible construction activities, affordable housing development
